COTTAGEVILLE PARK STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENTS CONSTRUCTION NEWSLETTER





PROJECT OVERVIEW

The City of Hopkins will begin storm sewer work on Cottageville Park the week of August 26th, weather permitting. During construction there should be limited impacts to the surrounding properties and the contractor will maintain all concrete curbing and sidewalks. Construction is anticipated to last 2 to 4 weeks from start to finish. Residents should expect to hear some construction noise from machinery and trucks at various times during working hours (Monday – Friday; 7 AM – 7 PM).

The storm sewer improvements area can be viewed on the map below, as shown in red, and will have construction signage posted on the nearby walkways. The City's Contractor will be improving and cleaning out the stormwater system that is under the grass field and leads to Minnehaha Creek. Residents will not be able to use the field within the construction area until work is completed, including underground work and turf restoration. However, residents will still be able to use the playground, shelter, garden, and other park amenities outside of the red area shown below during construction. Landscaping and turf vegetation that is disturbed during construction will be restored shortly after the improvements are made.

Some parking spaces in the area may be restricted as well to allow access for trucks and construction equipment. For any questions or concerns, please reach out to the project help line, project contacts, or visit the project website.
