



PERMIT APPLICATION CHECKLIST

EROSION CONTROL GENERAL PERMITS

Materials required for all EROSION CONTROL GENERAL PERMITS are outlined below. Projects qualifying for a General Permit are those that propose between 5,000 square feet and one acre of disturbance and/or propose the excavation, filling, or stockpiling of 50 cubic yards or more, trigger no other MCWD rules, and contain no waterbodies onsite.

PROPOSED SITE PLAN: EROSION CONTROL (Include the following):

Perimeter control along all roads and trails

Perimeter control at the bottom of all slopes leading off site or toward water resources

Perimeter control and/or stabilization for all stockpiles

Crushed rock or existing paved construction entrance

PROPOSED SITE PLAN: SITE FEATURES (Include the following):

Property lines

Existing and proposed elevation contours

Existing and proposed buildings, hard surface, and other significant structures

Existing and proposed drainage direction flow lines/arrows

PROPOSED SITE PLAN: WATER FEATURES (Include the following):

Identification and location of all water features within 1,000 feet of the project area and notation of whether the waterbody is impaired, has a special management waters status, and/or if it is a public water
