Summary:

The Wassermann Lake Preserve is a park and natural resource restoration on the shoreline of Lake Wassermann that has been a joint effort between the City of Victoria (the City) and Minnehaha Creek Watershed District (MCWD) since concept development in 2017. The project has advanced under two cooperative agreements with the City, the first governing concept development and the second governing design, construction, and operations and maintenance. Under the second cooperative agreement, the City committed to funding all projects elements related to the park improvements and MCWD to all elements related to the natural resource restoration.

In February 2020, a construction contract was awarded to LinnCo, Inc. Construction commenced in May 2020 and the final project walkthrough took place on August 18, 2021. Pending the completion of the closeout paperwork, the project will move into the warranty phase.

Upon project completion, the Victoria City Council requested that their staff investigate expanding the area of paved trails on the site. As constructed, the path from the shelter area to the boardwalk and on the island is crushed rock. The design team had proposed paving the additional trail length at the beginning of the project and requested a change order from LinnCo for the work, but the City did not pursue the proposal at that time. Paving the trail today will present additional technical challenges that increase project cost: The existing natural surface trail would have to be removed and a subgrade base installed; Approximately half the trail surface will require the installation of geotextile fabric in order to accommodate wet soils; and paving on the island itself presents a suite of unique challenges, and the limited access to the area would necessitate that the paving be complete primarily by hand.

LinnCo. provided a proposal for the trail paving for a total cost of \$134,440.14. The work would be complete as a change order to the project that would delay final completion of the project until the end of September. The City Council approved the change order on Monday, August 23. In alignment with the cooperative agreement, the cost of paving the trail would be born entirely by the City, however, Board approval of the change order is required because the cost exceeds the approved project budget.

WHEREAS,	the Minnehaha Creek Watershed District (MCWD) and City of Victoria ("City") identified the Wassermann West property (the Property), consisting of 33.5 acres of riparian land on the western shore of Wassermann Lake, as an opportunity for coordinated project development to meet strategic goals of both the MCWD and City by improving lake water quality, protecting and enhancing riparian wetland and shoreline, and affording public access to Wassermann Lake, among other potential project benefits;
WHEREAS,	on May 11, 2017, the MCWD Board of Managers authorized the execution of a cooperative agreement with the City that specified shared roles and responsibilities in developing a concept plan for the Wassermann Lake Preserve;
WHEREAS,	on May 23, 2019, the MCWD Board of Managers approved the second cooperative agreement, approving the park concept plan developed by both parties, identifying shared interests and responsibilities in carrying the Project forward through final design and construction, and authorizing staff to prepare a design and construction oversight scope for Board review and approval;
WHEREAS,	on August 22, 2019, the MCWD Board of Managers, with concurrence from the City Council, approved a design and construction oversight scope and contract with Aune Fernandez Landscape Architects (AFLA);
WHEREAS,	on February 27, 2020, the MCWD Board of Managers, with concurrence from City Council, awarded the construction contract to LinnCo, Inc. in the amount of \$1,839,825, and established a not to exceed budget of \$2,2023,810;
WHEREAS,	On July 20, 2021 at the request of City Council and staff, LinnCo provided a proposal for the paving of additional bituminous trail on site at the sole cost of the City;
WHEREAS,	on August 23, 2021, City Council approved the change order for trail paving at the Wassermann Lake Preserve.




