**Re:** Item 9.1: Annual Public Hearing for MCWD's Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan

## **Purpose:**

At the August 9, 2018 Board Meeting, there will be a public hearing to provide an opportunity for public comment on the District's Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP).

## **Background:**

The MCWD is regulated as a municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Phase II rules because the District is the drainage authority for eight public drainage systems.

The NPDES Phase II rules require that a public hearing be held annually to provide an opportunity for public input on the District's SWPPP. This hearing will be held at the August 9, 2018 Board Meeting. The hearing has been duly noticed in the Star Tribune and on the District website.
